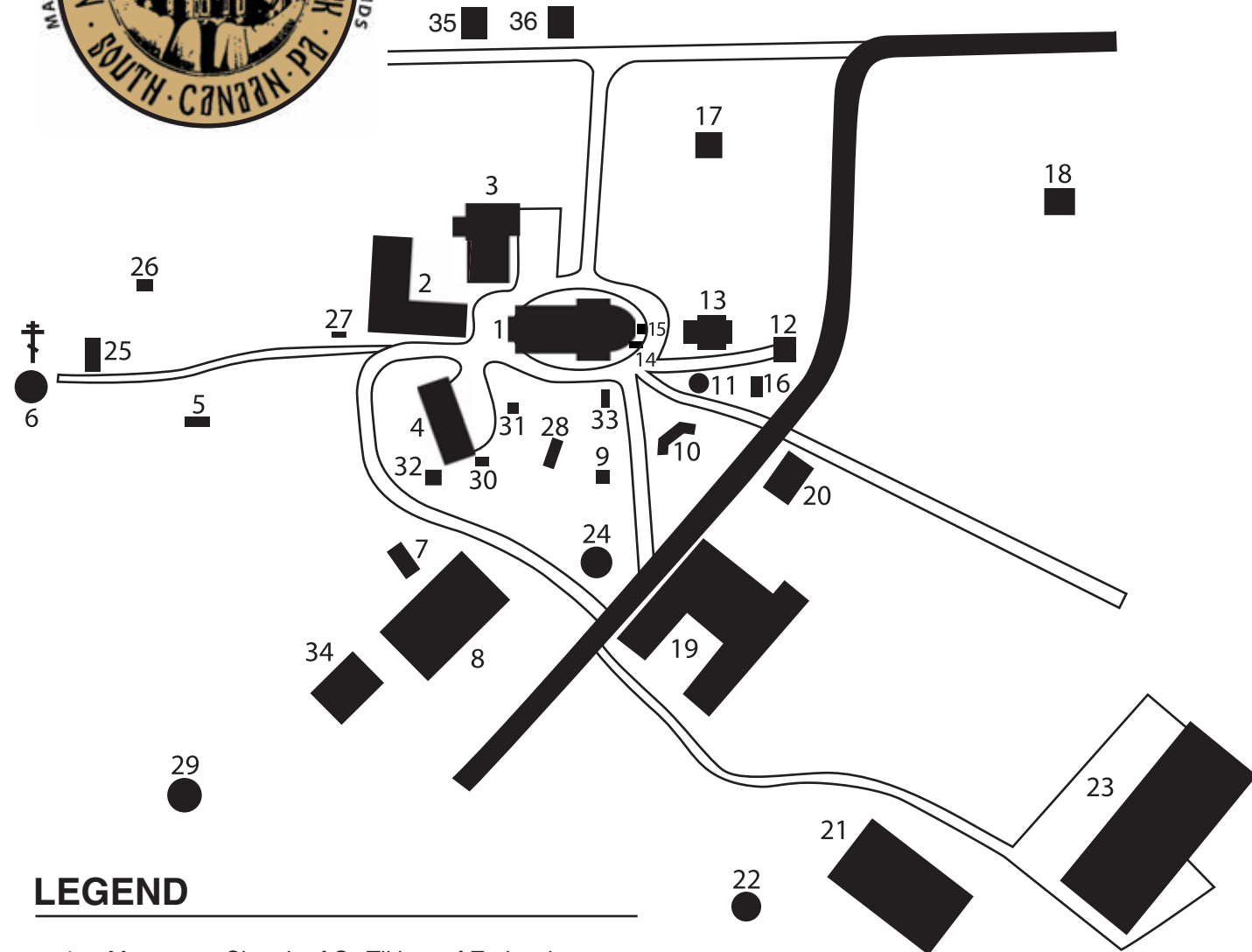




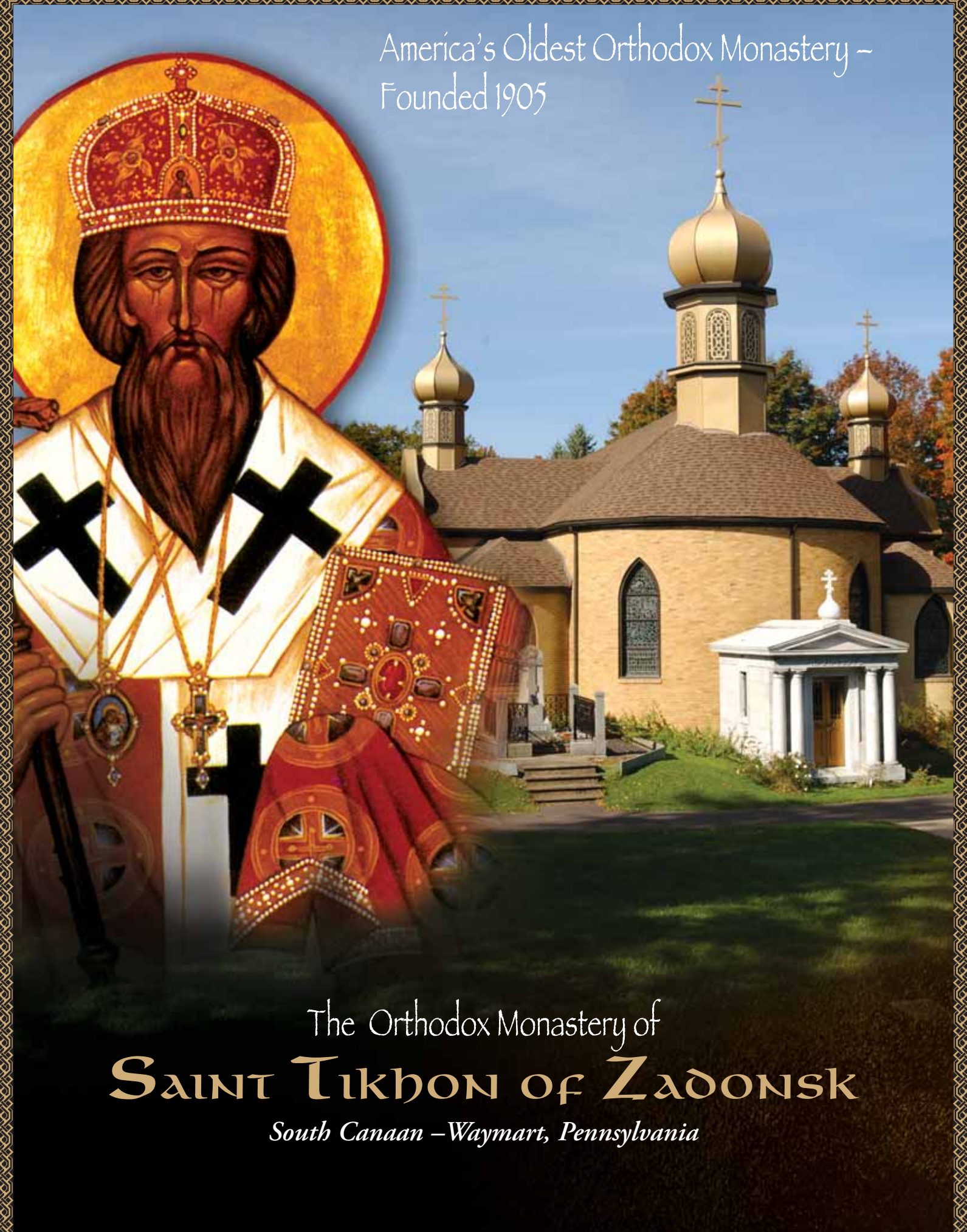

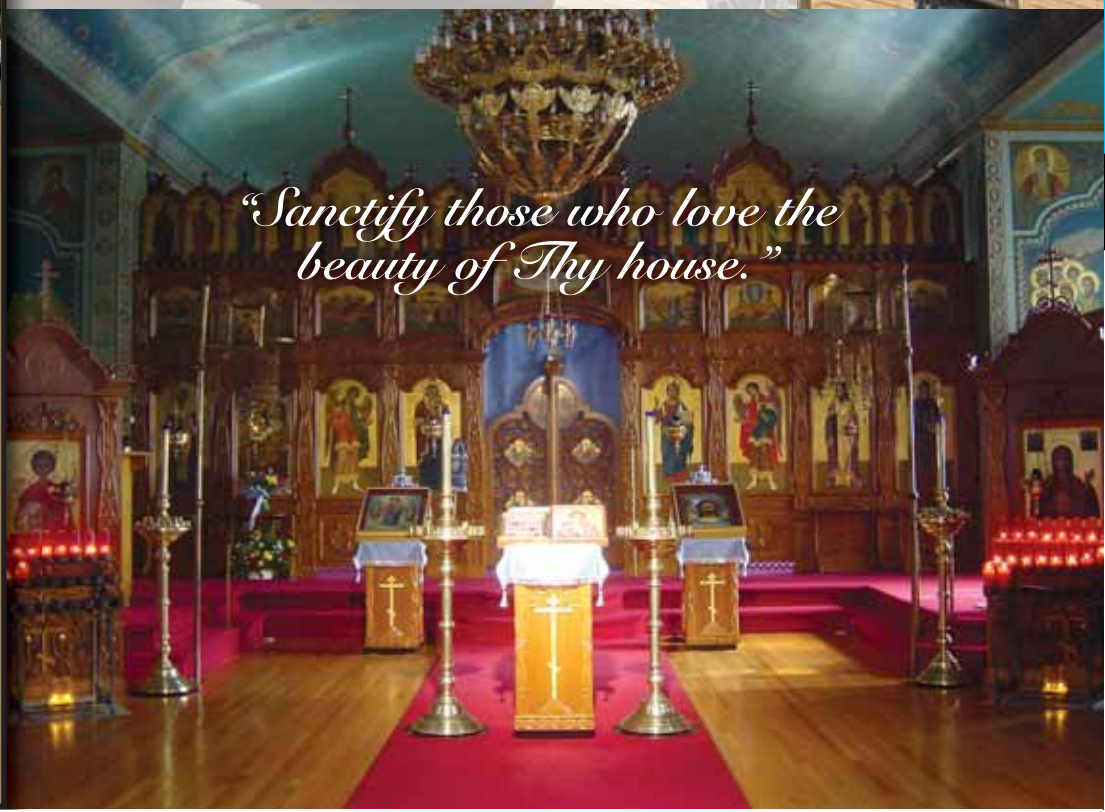

## BRIEF HISTORY

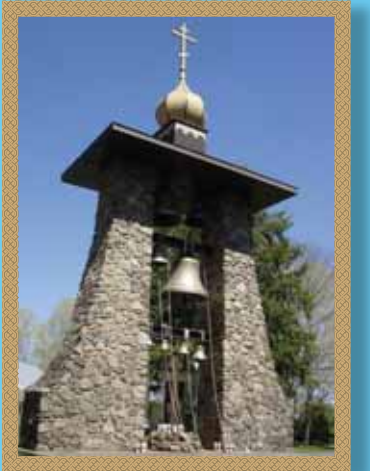

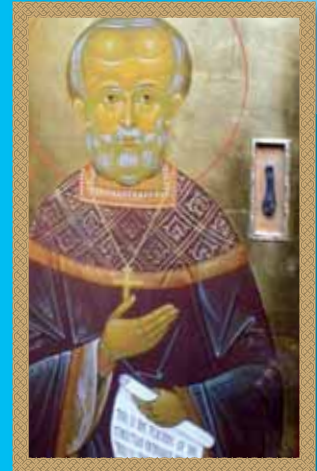
